### Mountain Destination Cancellation / Refund Policy

- Payment in full is due at time of registration.

Mailed Registration form including full payment must be postmarked by the Advance Registration Cutoff Date of 1 June, 2010 to qualify for posted Advance Registration Fees.

- Registration forms received without payment will not be processed at the time of receipt. When payment is received, registration will be processed at the fee in effect on the payment date.
- All fees must be paid in US funds drawn on a US bank.

### Workshop Registration Policies

- Workshops require additional registration separate from the annual conference. Please refer to Wednesday Workshop schedule pages for individual workshop registration rates.
- Registration fees for workshops and the annual conference may be combined into one payment.
- Workshop registration fees must be paid in full at the time of workshop registration. Workshop seating will not be held without payment at the time of registration. Note that workshops may have limited seating capacity.
- Should registration not reach minimum capacity for a given workshop, that workshop may be cancelled at the discretion of conference management. Registrants will be given notice at the time this decision is made.
- General cancellation dates and policies apply to both conference and workshop registrations.

### Non-Members

- Non-members may register at the "member rate" only if an application together with application fee and member dues are included with conference registration.

### Privacy Policy

The Association of Medical Illustrators (AMI) is committed to protecting the privacy of its members and customers. AMI recognizes the interest of its members and customers in the confidentiality of their personal information. AMI only maintains personal information that is relevant to AMI activities and seeks to maintain accurate, complete, and timely information. The security of personal information is important to AMI. AMI maintains all personal data with technical, administrative, and physical safeguards to protect against loss, unauthorized access, destruction, misuse, modification, and improper disclosure. No computer system or information can ever be fully protected against every possible hazard. AMI provides reasonable and appropriate security controls to protect personal information against foreseeable hazards.

AMI maintains member databases that contain mailing, billing, and member profile information, as well as a record of each member's product and service purchases. AMI also maintains databases of member and non-member purchases and of registrations for conferences and other AMI activities. The information in these databases is used by authorized AMI staff members to process orders; mail invoices, purchases, renewal notices, and announcements; respond to member inquiries; and help us improve our offerings.

All personally identifiable information contained in AMI membership, purchase, and registration databases is treated as confidential and will be used only for the purposes stated in this policy, except where required by law. Just like any other record keeper, AMI may be required to disclose personal information in response to valid legal process. This includes a search warrant, subpoena, or court order. Disclosures may also be appropriate to protect AMI's legal rights or during emergencies if physical safety is believed to be at risk. These disclosures are possible although unlikely. AMI does not maintain credit card information within its databases or other means of storage.
